FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TAKING COURSES WITH UNION COLLEGE

The BRIDGE Program is designed for high school juniors and seniors to acquire college credits while still attending high school. Students must be at least 16 years or older and have a least a "B" high school average.

TO APPLY:

- ✓ Meet with your high school guidance counselor to establish your academic goals and to discuss courses offered.
- ✓ Submit a Union College of Union County, NJ online application.
- ✓ Complete the Bridge Enrollment form and have it approved and signed by your parent/guardian and high school guidance counselor.
- ✓ Complete the Directed Self-Placement Math and English Surveys

TO QUALIFY: YOU MUST TEST OUT OF ALL REMEDIAL REQUIREMENTS BY TAKING THE DIRECTED SELF-PLACEMENT SURVEYS FOR MATH AND ENGLISH. IF A REMEDIAL REQUIREMENT IS INDICATED BY THE DSP, YOU MAY NOT ENROLL IN ANY COURSES OR SAT SCORES MINIMUM **540** IN CRITICAL READING/VERBAL AND **530** IN MATH. (Attach copies of scores).
